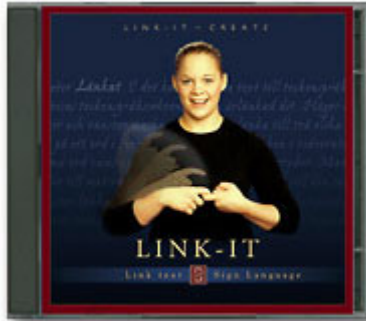

Link-it Create, Link-it Use, and their different license types

Link-it Create



Link-it Create, order no. 0930.

Both create and use

Link-it Create, is a combined create and use tool with which you can link text and Sign Language in many different ways. You can also replay this by clicking the text or the video.

Link lists

The products you create are called Link lists and can also be opened in the program Link-it Use.

Linked books

You can also produce programs which are independent versions of your Link lists, so called Linked books.

License alternatives for Link-it -Create

- 1 installation
- School license
- Commercial license

If you intend to sell what you are producing, you should choose commercial license. Other licenses are for non-commercial use.

Link-it Use



Link-it Use, order no. 0932.

Only use

Link-it Use, only contains the use part of the program.

Link lists

In this program you can open the Link lists you have created in Link-it Use. You can then click and see the links between the text and video in the Link list.

You cannot create new links or remove existing ones.

Flexible viewing

In the program Link-it Use you can, in the same way as in Link-it Create, select view mode, method of replay and size. In this way you can adjust the layout and functions to meet your requirements.

Bookmarks

As in Link-it Create, you can create bookmarks to links in the Link list you have opened.

Link lists, Linked books and bookmark lists

In Link-it Create, you can make translations, language comparisons, "dictionaries" in Sign Language or anything you want. You can then save these as Link lists and as Linked books.

Link lists



Link list is the product you create when you link text and Sign Language in Link-it Create.

Open in Link-it Create and in Link-it Use

Link lists can be opened and replayed by Link-it Create, but also in Link-it Use.

Flexible viewing

The person who created the Link list has specified which view mode, method of replay, text size etc. to be used when the Link list is opened. However, every user of the Link list can, when the Link list has been opened, adjust the layout and functions to meet their own requirements.

Possibility to create your own bookmarks

When the user opens the Link list, independent of which program it is opened with, it is possible to create bookmarks for existing links and enter information for these bookmarks. The user can also export these bookmarks to other users of the same Link list.

In some Link lists from the Swedish Institute for Special Needs Education complete bookmark lists are included.

Linked books



Linked book is a self-executing version of a Link list that can be used independent of the Link-it programs. The Linked book is created when you convert a Link list to a Linked book in Link-it Create.

Independent

Linked books can be opened and replayed in computers independent of the programs Link-it Create, or Link-it Use.

Limited viewing

The person who created the Linked book has specified view mode and method of replay for the Linked book. The user cannot change this.

However, the user can still adjust some functions such as information of links in the text, text size and if the video shall be replayed in full screen mode.

No bookmarks can be created

Users of the Linked book cannot create their own bookmarks for the links in the Linked book.

Link lists, Linked books, VIDEO on CD

Link lists

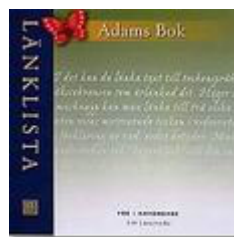
Pedagogically produced Link lists that are developed from our existing video grams. There are two different types of Link lists:

The video is part of the Link list.



In this type of Link list the video file is included.

The video is not part of the Link list.



In this Link list the video is not included. You need to have both the "VIDEO on CD" and the Link list for the current product to use the Link list with Link-it.

In the spring of 2003, the Swedish Institute for Special Needs Education started to create Link lists where the video is included except when it is beneficial to have the video on a separate CD (see below VIDEO on CD).

VIDEO on CD

VIDEO on CD is the generic term for the videograms that have been transferred to CD.

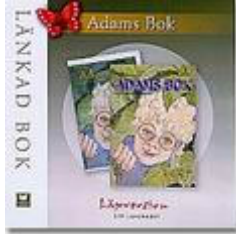


VIDEO on CD can be replayed on a computer, which makes it easier to navigate the video. You will also find information and links to other interesting material on the CD. In the VIDEO on CD version of Adam's Book you can for instance easily find the chapter you are looking for as well as teaching guides and student materials as copying materials and other information.

Some of your Link lists, such as the Link list Adam's Book, assume that you access to the VIDEO on CD version of Adam's Book.

Linked books

Most of the Link lists produced by the Swedish Institute for Special Needs Education are also sold as Linked books.



Linked books can be opened and replayed in computers without the programs Link-it Create, or Link-it Use. The Linked book also contains the video files.

You can very well use the Linked books when doing homework. The possibilities to adjust the view mode and method of replay for the Linked book are limited compared to a Link list. However, the teachers can from the Link lists create Linked books with other view modes based on every student's needs.
